R.C.I.A Program

There is an opportunity for those who would like to deepen their faith to come and support two adults who are discerning to join the Catholic Church from the Anglican Church on Every Tuesday evening from 7pm-830pm from the 3rd of February 2026 - 10th of March 2026. It will be a good opportunity to share your faith and for others to get to know you.

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the Catholic Church's process for welcoming adults (and older children) into full communion, involving learning faith, spiritual formation, and receiving Sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil, guided by a parish community over several stages of inquiry, learning, and reflection

What it is:

- **A Journey:** More than a course, it's a gradual, personal journey of faith formation and spiritual growth.
- **For Everyone:** Open to the unbaptized, baptized Christians from other faiths, and even Catholics wanting a deeper understanding.

Process (Stages):

1. **Pre-catechumenate** (Inquiry): Exploring the faith with no pressure.
2. **Catechumenate:** Deeper learning of Church teachings, history, and traditions, leading to the Rite of Acceptance.
3. **Purification & Enlightenment:** Intense spiritual reflection, leading to the Easter Sacraments.
4. **Mystagogy:** Post-initiation reflection and integration into parish life.
